PART 2: NEW ON THE INSIDE

Last week we began to explore God's Word about being renewed and getting a fresh start. As we discussed last week, our past can often trip us up when we try to focus on Jesus to renew us. This is why we have to get our past out of our present. This week, we are going to explore God's Word to seek what being renewed is all about!

EZEKIEL 36:26-27 (pg. 798)

① Our old spirit is broken and damaged...

⇒ **ROMANS 1:18-25**

⇒ We are designed to live for the glory of God, yet that is not what we do. Instead we live for something far less.

⇒ Even if we try to pass the blame, we only have ourselves to blame. We have no legitimate excuse.

⇒ **ROMANS 1:28-32**

⇒ The results of our lives without God.

② In Jesus, a new you is possible...

⇒ Left on our own, we have no hope, but, like we seen last week, God is beyond generous to us.

⇒ **ROMANS 5:6-11**

⇒ Jesus makes a way for you to be saved from the old you and all the horrible consequences that comes with it. He does it by renewing you and making a whole new you!

③ Your new life starts now...

⇒ **ROMANS 6:1-11**

⇒ WHAT? We don't have to wait until after death to have a new life! We get a new life now!!!

⇒ So many times, we walk around feeling defeated and worthless, yet when we are in Jesus, we are more than victorious (Romans 8:37) and cherished!

⇒ Why keep looking to the old, broken, damaged spirit, when you can have (or do have if you are in Christ) a new, abundantly victorious, and cherished spirit?
